Extreme weather conditions, including a lack of appreciable precipitation, low relative humidity, high temperatures, and high winds have created a condition of extreme fire danger for Clinton County.

As a result of these extreme conditions, and the undue risk to life and property that wildfire in these conditions may pose to the public, and emergency response personnel it is ordered:

All Open Burning in Clinton County, Missouri is prohibited until further notice. Furthermore, the discharge of fireworks during this period poses an extreme risk to life and property of persons within the County. Persons choosing to engage in the discharge of fireworks are warned that they will be held civilly and potentially criminally liable for damages caused by the discharge of fireworks, or open burning during this ban.
